

- 1 Q. Is the 110 MW biofuel-fired combustion turbine generator in Campbell Industrial Park (1st paragraph, page 4) the same as the H-POWER facility (mentioned in the same paragraph) being pursued by the City and County?

A. No, these are two separate projects.
- 2 Q. As a follow-up to the previous question, the SOI seems to imply that the 110 MW Campbell Industrial Park facility is a 'grandfathered' proposal. Is this true? If true, would the capacity of this plant negate the need to acquire renewable energy through the planned RFP?

A. The Company's 110 MW Campbell Industrial Park CT-1 project currently being developed is exempted from the Competitive Bidding Framework (Section II.A.3.e.). The capacity of this CT-1 project will not negate the Company's plans to acquire non-firm renewable energy through this RFP.
- 3 Q. The last sentence of Section B, page 8 reads, "Threshold and evaluation criteria, both price and non-price, will be defined in the proposed RFP." Does this mean that responders to the RFP should include in their proposals the rate they intend to charge to HECO for the renewable energy generated? Or is this negotiated after the selection of a winning bidder(s)?

A. Yes, the RFP Response Package will contain a section for bidders to provide their proposed pricing information.
